Oxford is Britain's oldest university, and it has quadrangles, gothic spires and listed buildings crammed into its easily accessible centre. With its cobbled lanes, canals, rivers, museums and botanical

gardens, cafes and pubs, libraries and galleries, there is no shortage of things to do and see. Oxford is widely considered a very walkable city with many attractions close together.
